



## **KIDS CLUB 2026: Frequently Asked Questions**

### **What is it?**

St Johns Maroubra Kids Club is a school holiday activity program for kids which runs for three days (9am – 3pm) in the first week of the July school holidays. Each day includes activities, games, craft, bible stories and music and even a live action drama each day as our story unfolds. Morning tea and lunch will be provided.

For the first time, we are also running Kids Club Plus which will run from 3-5pm. This part of the day is FREE for any children who would like to stay on after Kids Club. It will include afternoon tea, games and craft.

### **Where is it?**

St Johns Maroubra, 339a Maroubra Road, Maroubra 2035

### **What ages can attend?**

Kindergarten to Year 6

### **What are the dates and times?**

Monday 6th to Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> July, 9am-3pm for Kids Club

Monday 6th to Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> July, 3-5pm for Kids Club Plus (for children who attended the morning program but want (or need) to stay a little longer)

### **How much does it cost?**

Day ticket = \$35, all three days (Mon-Wed) = \$85. Kids Club Plus = FREE

### **What is included in the cost?**

Morning tea, lunch and all craft and activities. Afternoon tea is also provided for Kids Club Plus.

### **What if I can't afford it?**

Don't let the cost stop you from coming, email our office if you're interested in a subsidised ticket ([office@stjohnsmaroubra.com](mailto:office@stjohnsmaroubra.com)).

### **How do I register my child to attend?**

Register on our website as early as possible to avoid disappointment. We do allow limited registrations on the day, but these are subject to availability.

### **What if my child has special needs?**

We want our Kids Club to be accessible for all children. Please note any special needs or requirements for your child in your registration form or contact our office ([office@stjohnsmaroubra.com](mailto:office@stjohnsmaroubra.com)) for more information.

### **What does a typical morning look like?**

<b>8:45-9am</b>	Arrival and Parent/Caregiver sign in
<b>9-10am</b>	All-together time – fun challenges, music and live action drama
<b>10am-12:30pm</b>	Group time – games and activities, craft, bible stories and morning tea
<b>12.30/1pm</b>	Lunch
<b>1.30-2.30pm</b>	Group time – games and activities, craft
<b>2.30-3pm</b>	More all-together time
<b>3pm</b>	Parent/caregiver sign out and departure (unless staying for Kids Club Plus)
<b>3-5pm</b>	Kids Club Plus (games, activities, afternoon tea)

### **What does a typical morning tea/lunch/afternoon tea look like?**

A typical morning tea consists of fruit (e.g. oranges, bananas, mandarins, grapes, strawberries), home-made biscuits, slices, cake etc, hot food (different type each day e.g. chicken nuggets, spring rolls, pizza) and a drink of water.

### **What about allergies and dietary requirements?**

Please note any allergies or special dietary requirements in your registration form.

We have a nut free policy; however some food may contain coconut. We do NOT offer gluten free alternatives although some of our food will be gluten free. We do NOT offer vegan alternatives although some of our food will be meat free.

**Why do I need to sign my child in and out?**

We require an authorised parent/caregiver to sign their child/children in and out as evidence of the transfer of care responsibilities.

**What about health and safety?**

Children are supervised at all times. All our team have current Working with Children Checks and meet the Safe Ministry requirements of the Anglican Church. Group meeting areas have undergone safety risk assessments. We encourage regular hand washing/sanitising for infection control.

**What if my child is sick?**

We ask that you assist by keeping your children home if they are experiencing any symptoms/sickness.

**What about Refunds and Cancellations?**

If you are unable to attend due to sickness / other misadventure please contact our office ([office@stjohnsmaroubra.com](mailto:office@stjohnsmaroubra.com)) and request a refund.
